

Mosaica Needs Consultants/Part-time Personnel – Community Research and Nonprofit Capacity Building

Mosaica: The Center for Nonprofit Development and Pluralism is looking for a few Washington, DC area consultants and/or temporary staff to help us with community-based needs assessment, advocacy evaluation, and organizational development assistance to small nonprofits. Mosaica is a values-based multicultural nonprofit that provides tools to other nonprofits to build just, inclusive, and thriving communities.

We are looking for people who do not necessarily have a great deal of work experience, but share our commitment to nonprofits, have life experience in communities of color and low-income communities and with nonprofits serving them, and bring excellent brains, a strong work ethic, and generic skills (like good writing or training skills or knowledge of social media). Of particular interest is training in public health, human services, or community research methods. Most of our research is qualitative or small-sample, but quantitative skills are also welcome. We help nonprofits with strategic planning and many kinds of capacity building.

Mosaica has two 9-12 month fellowship positions targeting people who have finished an undergraduate degree but may not yet have much work experience. We also need some consultants who can help with particular projects or work part-time. For example, we can be flexible on hours if you are going to graduate school and want part-time work. Candidates must be local, since we do most of our work in teams. Consultant hourly pay depends on skills and experience, but is generally \$25-\$35 per hour. Check out our website, www.mosaica.org.
